

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-018

Amending Ordinance 2013-036 granting encroachment to the South Carolina Budget and Control Board for installation and maintenance of handicap ramp, front step, handrails, repaving of concrete sidewalk and landscaping within the right of way area adjacent to its building at 1026-1028 Sumter Street to include sod and brick pavers

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2013-036 dated April 16, 2013, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, granted the South Carolina Budget and Control Board (hereinafter "Grantee") the right to use a portion of the right of way area of the 1000 block of Sumter Street adjacent to its building at 1026-1028 Sumter Street, Richland County TMS #11304-02-01, for installation and maintenance of a handicap ramp approximately five (5') foot four (4") inches in width and twenty-eight (28') feet in length with handrails; a front step approximately five (5') foot four (4") inch in width and nine (9') feet in length with handrails; repaving of the concrete sidewalk and landscaping; and,

WHEREAS, Grantee desires to amend the encroachment ordinance to allow for installation and maintenance of sod and brick pavers approximately seven (7') feet in width and one hundred fifty-five (155') feet in length within the right of way area of the 1000 block of Sumter Street adjacent to its building at 1026-1028 Sumter Street, as shown on the attached drawing; and,

WHEREAS, it appears that the encroachment will not interfere with the use of the medians or street for traffic, utility locations or other uses within the foreseeable future; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, this 1st day of April, 2014, that Ordinance 2013-036 dated April 16, 2013 is hereby amended to all for the installation and maintenance of sod and brick pavers approximately seven (7') feet in width and one hundred fifty-five (155') feet in length within the right of way area of the 1000 block of Sumter Street adjacent to its building at 1026-1028 Sumter Street, as shown on the attached drawing.

ALL WORK SHALL COMPLY with the requirements of The City of Columbia and South Carolina Department of Transportation now in existence or hereafter enacted. The materials and type of finish to be used are to be approved by the City Engineer prior to installation. Any damage to the street or sidewalk caused by construction shall be repaired to the satisfaction of the City Manager. Improvements within the encroachment shall be maintained by the grantee at no cost to the City in a manner approved by the City Manager.

PROVIDED FURTHER that the privilege granted hereby is subject to the Grantee complying with the following conditions, restrictions or limitations:

1. No item, including landscaping, shall be placed, planted or allowed to grow such that it creates a visual impediment to persons safely entering or exiting the driveway or to persons safely walking along the sidewalk. The City reserves the right to remove or cut any item located within the right of way which it deems to be a safety hazard.
2. Grantee is responsible for all maintenance and assuring that all accessibility and ADA requirements are met and maintained.

3. Landscaping to be maintained by property owner.
4. Irrigation must be designed to avoid spraying walkways, sidewalks and streets and/or creating hazardous conditions upon the walkways, sidewalks and streets.
5. All trees shall be protected and no large tree roots shall be removed from any existing trees.

PROVIDED FURTHER that the privilege granted hereby may be modified or terminated by Columbia City Council at any time without notice to the Grantee, its successors and assigns.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Grantee, in consideration of the above privilege, shall at its expense provide for protection and relocation of all utilities that might be within this area to the satisfaction of the City Manager.





REQUEST FOR AN ENCROACHMENT ORDINANCE

NARRATIVE

Location: 1026 Sumter Street, Columbia, South Carolina

February 6, 2013

Request for Encroachment to install handicap accessible entrance, renovate concrete sidewalk, and provide landscape strip near street curb.

Remove existing sidewalk in front of building to renovate the entire area between building and curb. This area is approximately 1085 s.f.

In this area remove the steel pipe and railing next the to building as they no longer serve a purpose.

Provide new front stoop large enough for handicap entry and maneuvering at front door, with ramps and railings installed from both sides of the stoop. With extension of handrails, the extent of the ramps and stoop are 5'-4" wide and 28'-0" long, next to the outside wall of the building.

Reserve the 7'-6" strip along the curb line for grass planting. Prepare with soil amendments and sod. This landscaped area is in City of Columbia r.o.w.
