**ORDINANCE NO.: 2015-028**

*Amending the 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina,  
Chapter 15, Parks and Recreation, Sec. 15-1 Prohibited Acts in parks,  
(8) Alcoholic beverages is amended to add Earlewood Community Building and Park*

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council this 21st day of April, 2015, that the 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter 15, Parks and Recreation, Sec. 15-1 Prohibited acts in parks (8) Alcoholic beverages is amended to read as follows:

(8) Alcoholic beverages. Possess and/or consume alcoholic beverages, beer or wine; provided, however, alcoholic beverages, beer or wine, shall be allowed in Capital City Ball Park, Riverfront Park, Keenan House, Finlay Park, the Print Building next to the Eau Claire Town Hall, Drew Wellness Center, Boyd Plaza, and Coble Plaza, Earlewood Community Building and Park as follows:

a. At events open to the public when possession and consumption is specifically authorized by resolution of Columbia City Council and the event organizer obtains a permit or license if required by the South Carolina Department of Revenue for the possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages, beer or wine at the event; or

b. At private functions, authorized by the city, for which the South Carolina Department of Revenue does not require a permit or license for the possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages, beer or wine.
