BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council this 18th day of November, 2009, that the 1998 Code of Ordinances of The City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter 5, Buildings and Building Regulations, Article II, Building and Technical Code, Division 8, Sec. 5-171, Adoption; conflicting provisions, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 5-171. Adoption; conflicting provisions.

(a) There is hereby adopted by and for the city the International Energy Conservation Code 2006 edition as adopted by the South Carolina Building Code Council, Inc., which code is published separately in book form and is adopted by reference as though copied fully in this section. Any provision concerning the qualification, removal, dismissal and duties of the building official or any other city employee are deemed excluded from this section. A file of record of this code is in the offices of the city clerk and building official.

(b) In the event of any conflict between the provisions of the code adopted by this section and state law or city ordinances, rules or regulations, then the code adopted by this section shall prevail and be controlling unless the code is specifically amended by state law which shall prevail and be controlling.
