
BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council this 1st day of October, 2013, that the 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter 2, Administration, Article II, Division I, Generally, Sec. 2-56, Appearance of citizens is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-56. Appearance of citizens.

Any person having a matter pertaining to the city, comments on an agenda item requiring a vote of city council, or its services shall be entitled to present the matter to the city council at any regular, special called or emergency meeting by placing his or her name and purpose for speaking on an agenda list to be maintained by the city clerk prior to the commencement of the city council meeting. The city clerk shall make the agenda list available for public inspection. Except for comments on agenda items requiring a vote of city council, each ~~Each~~ person whose name appears on the agenda list may be allowed to speak at a time designated by the mayor during the city council meeting and may be limited to a three minute presentation at the discretion of the mayor. For comments on agenda items requiring a vote of city council, each person shall be allowed to speak prior to the vote of city council on the agenda item. Personnel matters shall not be considered by the council at public meetings.


