

ORDINANCE NO.: 2000-064

*Prohibiting parking in certain areas on the 1900 block of Park Street,
the 900 block of Richland Street, the 1900 block of Lincoln Street
and the 900 block of Calhoun Street*

WHEREAS, the United States of America is constructing a new Federal Courthouse to be known as the Matthew J. Perry, Jr. Courthouse; and,

WHEREAS, in order to afford appropriate security to the Courthouse, the Court personnel and the public, it is desirous and necessary to restrict the parking of vehicles on the perimeter streets surrounding the Courthouse; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, South Carolina this 13th day of September, 2000, that effective as of October 1, 2000, it shall be unlawful to park any vehicles on the western side of the 1900 block of Park Street, the northern side of the 900 block of Richland Street and the eastern side of the 1900 block of Lincoln Street, and the southern side of the 900 block of Calhoun Street, except for vehicles authorized by the United States Marshall or the Clerk of the United States District Court.


