Amending the 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter 2, Administration, Article IV, Departments, Sec. 12-151, Departments created; department heads; administrative regulations and procedures, (a) to repeal (20) Homeland security

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council this 17th day of February, 2010, that the 1998 Code of Ordinances of The City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter 2, Administration, Article IV, Departments, Sec. 12-151, Departments created; department heads; administrative regulations and procedures (a) is amended to repeal (20) Homeland security, read as follows:

Sec. 2-151. Departments created; department heads; administrative regulations and procedures.

(a) The following departments of the city are created:

- (1) City clerk;
- (2) Information technology;
- (3) Finance;
- (4) Legal;
- (5) Human resources;
- (6) Municipal court;
- (7) Police;
- (8) Fire;
- (9) Public works;
- (10) Utilities and engineering;
- (11) Community development;
- (12) Parks and recreation;
- (13) General services;
- (14) Economic development;
- (15) Business enterprise and grants;
- (16) Zoning, inspections and planning;
- (17) Construction management;
- (18) Public relations;
- (19) Communications (911/311);

(b) The head of each department shall be a director, who shall be an officer of the city and shall have supervision and control of his department, subject to the city manager. The city manager may serve as director of one or more departments or divisions within any department.

(c) Each department head shall be responsible for preparation of departmental and administrative regulations and procedures subject to the review and approval of the city manager.

This ordinance is effective as of March 1, 2010.


