*Amending the 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina,
Chapter 12, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Article II, Stopping, Standing and Parking,
Division 1, Generally, Sec. 12-42 Storage of commercial vehicles*

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council this 19th day of July, 2011, that the 1998 Code of Ordinances of The City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter 12, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Article II, Stopping, Standing and Parking, Division 1, Generally, Sec. 12-42 Storage of commercial vehicles is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 12-42. Storage of commercial vehicles, recreational vehicles or trailers on streets.

No person shall store or permit to be stored any commercial vehicle, recreational vehicle or trailer of any size or description, upon any of the streets of the city. For the purpose of this section, storage shall mean the leaving or parking of such vehicle unattended on a street for a longer time than two hours, day or night or unmoved from its location on a street for a longer time than two hours, day or night, with no obvious sign of continuous human use during the two hour period. For the purposes of this section, the term "street" shall include any area within the street right-of-way including the area between the curb-line and adjacent property lines.


