

RESOLUTION NO.: R-2000-026

Authorizing Sidewalk Sales for Columbia Museum of Art
at 1515 Main Street

WHEREAS, The Museum Shop of the Columbia Museum of Art ("Museum") desires to hold sidewalk sales during their normal business hours of 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Tuesdays through Saturdays in May and June, 2000, on the sidewalk immediately adjacent to its store located at 1515 Main Street; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such sales would be in the public interest; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 24th day of May, 2000, that during the normal business hours of 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Tuesdays through Saturdays in May and June, 2000, the Museum is authorized to hold sidewalk sales for items normally sold in its course of business, except alcoholic beverages, beer and wine, on the sidewalk immediately in front of its place of business located at 1515 Main Street; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that sidewalks shall not be obstructed for pedestrian traffic in violation of Code Sec. 22-72, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, and that no solicitation or transactions be made in violation of Code Sec. 14-32, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, and that no vendor locations be allowed on any street during the period of the sidewalk sales.
