WHEREAS, the above-referenced streets are located in the city limits of Columbia in Ashewood Subdivision, Phase 3. The approval of the development plans for Ashewood Subdivision, Phase 3 included dedication of the streets to the City of Columbia; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Construction Management has inspected the streets on the said property and found that they were constructed in compliance with the City's ordinances and regulations and recommends approval for acceptance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, South Carolina this 7th day of May, 2008, that the City of Columbia accept dedication of the aforesaid streets known as Ashewood Lake Drive, Paperbark Court, and Gayle Pond Trace in Ashewood Subdivision, Phase 3.


