

RESOLUTION NO.: R-2010-096

*Authorizing consumption of beer and wine at the
River Rocks at the Columbia Canal Park*

WHEREAS, Congaree Riverkeeper ("Sponsor") is sponsoring "River Rocks" in the Amphitheater Area of Riverfront Park from 12:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 30, 2011; and,

WHEREAS, the Sponsor has requested permission to allow the consumption of beer and wine beverages by its patrons at the event; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the public interest; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 16th day of November, 2010, that the sale of beer and wine is authorized between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. on Saturday, April 30, 2011 in the Amphitheater Area of Riverfront Park; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pets shall be allowed provided they are leashed and under the owners' control at all times. Patrons are prohibited from bringing alcoholic beverages, glass bottles and breakable glasses and/or cups, grills and radios, boom boxes and other musical devices, backpacks and large bags; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during the designated time the Amphitheater Area of Riverfront Park shall be declared to be a Public Park and provisions of Chapter 15, Parks and Recreation, Sec. 15-1, 15-2 and 15-3, Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina are in effect. Pursuant to Chapter 14, Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, Article IV, Offenses Against the Public Peace and Order, Sec. 14-99, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, the Amphitheater Area of Riverfront Park is deemed to be the site of a public festival at which beer and wine may be consumed

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and the prohibition against possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages as set forth in Sec. 14-99 shall not apply.

PROVIDED, FURTHER, that the event organizer shall provide the names and cell phone numbers of a least two contact persons who can receive complaints during the event, including any set up and breakdown times. The cell phones shall remain on at all times during the event and during any set up and breakdown time.

PROVIDED, FURTHER, that failure of the event organizer to strictly comply with the time frames and other requirements and responsibilities set forth in this resolution may result in a denial of subsequent requests to allow the event.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that no solicitation or transactions be made in violation of Sec. 14-32, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina.



Tentative Schedule of Events

9 am to 9 pm Park reserved:

Canal Park, in the vicinity of the stage, will be reserved from 9 am to 9 pm. Tickets will be sold to attend this event.

9 am to 11 am Sculling Race:

A sculling race will be held on the Broad River from 9 am to 11 am. The finish line will be the Columbia Rowing Club facility.

Noon to 2 pm Downriver Race:

A downriver, whitewater canoe / kayak race will be held from noon to 2 pm. The race will start above Mill Race Rapid, at Riverbanks Zoo and end at the Columbia Canal Park.

2 to 4 pm Flatwater Race:

A flatwater canoe / kayak race will be held from 2 pm to 4 pm. The race will start at the head of the Columbia Canal and end at the stage area.

4 pm to 5 pm Stand-up Paddle Board (SUPB) race:

A short (100 yds.) stand-up paddle board race will take place on the Columbia Canal near the stage area. This race may be composed of a series of heats, with a final race composed of heat winners.

5 pm to 6 pm tube races:

"For Fun" tube races may take place from 5 pm to 6 pm on the Columbia Canal near the stage area. Celebrities may be enlisted to take part.

Noon to 8 pm music at the stages:

Music will take place at the stages from noon till 8 pm. Rock band music will take place at the riverfront stage and acoustical music at the small amphitheatre. Bands will alternate at each location. Beer and wine will be sold during the music event, from noon till 7:30 pm.

Noon til 8 pm tables and booths: Outfitters and vendors will have tables / booths along the Canal throughout this event.

9 am to 2 pm shuttle:

Outfitters will maintain a van shuttle service for race participants from the south (State Museum) end of the canal. The shuttle service will be available from 9 am to 2 pm. Race participants will be shuttled prior to their race.

11 am to Noon and 8 pm to 9 pm Set-up and Take-down:

Set-up will take place from 11 am to Noon and take-down will take place from 8 pm to 9 pm.
