

**RESOLUTION NO.: R-2011-013**

*Authorizing the Five Points Association to Conduct Street  
and Sidewalk Sales for the "St. Pat's in Five Points Festival"*

WHEREAS, the Five Points Association is sponsoring the "St. Pat's in Five Points Festival" to raise funds for charity, beautification and revitalization of the Five Points area on Saturday, March 19, 2011, with rain contingencies to include Saturday night and Sunday, March 20, 2011; and,

WHEREAS, the Association has requested the temporary closing and use of the 2100 block of Greene Street from 1:00 p.m. Friday, March 18, 2011 until 7:00 p.m. Saturday, March 19, 2011; the 600 block of Harden Street, and Santee Avenue between Harden Street and Blossom Street from 6:00 p.m. Friday, March 18, 2011 until 7:00 p.m. Saturday, March 19, 2011; the Five Points area bounded by Gervais, Blossom, Heidt, and Lauren Streets on Friday, March 19, 2010 from 2:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. for preparation and staging of the area for an outdoor event to be held on Saturday, March 19, 2011 between 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., and for patrons to consume beer and wine at the event during the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.; and,

WHEREAS, the Association has requested permission to conduct sidewalk sales as part of the celebration; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the best public interest; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 25th day of January, that between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 19, 2011 (and in the event of rain, from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Sunday, March 20, 2011) within the Five Points area bounded by Gervais, Blossom, Heidt, and Lauren Streets, merchants in Five Points are authorized to operate sale booths for items normally sold in their course of business on the sidewalks immediately in front of their places of business; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that outdoor possession and consumption of beer and wine beverages, all outdoor musical performances and use of sound-amplifying devices shall end by 10:00 p.m. due to the proximity of the event to residential properties; and,**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that street sales of arts and crafts items (to be defined as items which are in whole or in part handmade and not items purchased for resale) and food and beverage items and game booths be permitted and that the Association be authorized to determine and allocate available space to vendors and to charge reasonable fees to cover its costs in promoting and operating the festival. The Association may limit the number of vendors based on the space available. The Five Points Association sponsored beer sales are authorized between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 19, 2011. The Five Points Association sponsored food sales will stop at 6:30 p.m. on Saturday, March 19, 2011. In the event of rain on Saturday, March 19, 2011, beer sales shall be extended through 9:30 p.m. and food sales shall be extended through 10:00 p.m. The Association shall prescribe the required application form and appropriate deadline for receiving application; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location and the Association shall approve or disapprove all amplified entertainment activities; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that only pedestrian traffic will be allowed within the area designated on the attached map. All other traffic, including, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, mopeds, bicycles, skateboards, and horses, except police horses, are prohibited. Pets shall be prohibited. Coolers, glass bottles, breakable glasses and/or breakable cups, and backpacks shall be prohibited in the festival area as designated on the attached map; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during the designated time the area shown on the attached map is designated to be a Public Park and provisions of Chapter 15, Parks and Recreation, Sec. 15-1, 15-2 and 15-3, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina are in effect. Pursuant to Chapter 14, Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, Article IV, Offenses Against the Public Peace and Order, Sec. 14-99, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, the area designated on the attached map is deemed to be the site of a public festival at which alcoholic beverages may be consumed and the prohibition against possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages as set forth in Sec. 14-99 shall not apply, however,

possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only in containers provided by the Five Points Association within the area designated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should it rain on Saturday, March 19, 2011, the Festival's hours of operation will be extended until 10:00 p.m. Furthermore, depending on the amount of rain during the event Saturday March 19, 2011, and in the sole judgment of the Five Points Association, its Board of Directors and the St. Pat's in Five Points Committee, the event will also be extended to include Sunday, March 20, 2011, between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event of rain the event is extended to include Sunday, March 20, 2011, beer sales shall be authorized between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. and food sales shall be authorized between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, March 20, 2011; and,

PROVIDED, FURTHER, the street and sidewalk sale shall be allowed during either of these dates and hours of operation as listed above.

PROVIDED, FURTHER, that in the event that it does not rain, Santee Avenue between Harden Street and Blossom Street shall be closed to through traffic, and parking by non-residents shall be prohibited within the Five Points area bounded by Gervais, Blossom, Heidt and Laurens Streets as shown on the attached map between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. Saturday, March 19, 2011. In the event of rain, the streets shall be closed through 3:00 a.m. Sunday March 20, 2011.

PROVIDED, FURTHER, in the event that it does rain on Saturday, March 19, 2011, the Five Points area bounded by Gervais, Blossom, Heidt and Laurens Streets as shown on the attached map shall be closed to through traffic, and parking by non-residents shall be prohibited, Sunday, March 20, 2011, between the hours of 12:01 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

PROVIDED, FURTHER, that the event organizer shall provide the names and cell phone numbers of a least two contact persons who can receive complaints during the event, including any set up and breakdown times. The cell phones shall remain on at all times during the event and during any set up and breakdown time.



**Park Rules for the Five Points Association to Conduct Street and Sidewalk Sales for  
St. Pat's in Five Points Festival 2011  
(R-2011-013)**

WHEREAS, Columbia City Council has adopted Resolution R-2011-013 allowing the Five Points Association to Conduct Street and Sidewalk Sales for "St. Pat's In Five Points Festival" to be held on Saturday, March 19, 2011 with rain contingencies for Sunday, March 20, 2011, in the Five Points area bounded by Cervais, Blossom, Heidt, and Lauren Streets; and,

WHEREAS, certain areas of the public rights of way and public property have been designated as a public park for the event as more particularly set forth in Resolution R-2011-013, which is incorporated herein by specific reference thereto; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Parks and Recreation Department hereby authorizes the use of the public park designated by Resolution R-2011-013 for the Five Points Association to Conduct Street and Sidewalk Sales for "St. Pat's In Five Points Festival"; and,

WHEREAS, City Ordinance Sec. 15-1 (12) and Sec. 15-3 permit the Director of Parks and Recreation to promulgate rules and regulations within a public park, subject to the approval of the City Manager; and,

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that a large number of City of Columbia citizens and visitors will attend the event and will be allowed to consume beer and wine within the public park; and,

WHEREAS, in order to promote the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Columbia and visitors attending the event, I find it necessary to promulgate rules and regulations to apply within the public park established pursuant to Resolution R-2011-013; NOW, THEREFORE


The following additional park rules are hereby promulgated for the Five Points Association to Conduct Street and Sidewalk Sales for "St. Pat's In Five Points Festival" and shall apply within the area designated as a public park:

1. Official festival wristbands are required for entry or re-entry into the designated park area.
2. Over age twenty-one (21) wristbands from the identification check station are required for patrons to consume beer or wine in the designated park area.
3. All persons under the age of sixteen (16) must be accompanied by an adult.
4. No glass containers are allowed.
5. No coolers, outside food or beverages (including alcohol) are allowed.
6. No backpacks or bags are allowed.
7. Only beer and wine are permitted. No other alcoholic beverages of any kind are allowed, *unless within an area permitted by an existing encroachment ordinance which permits the serving of beer, wine and other alcoholic beverages during its normal course of business.*
8. All beer and wine must be served and consumed from a plastic cup, a plastic bottle, an aluminum can or an aluminum bottle.
9. No pets are allowed.

Violation of these rules may result in criminal prosecution.

The aforesaid rules shall be prominently displayed on signage which shall be located at all entrances into the designated park area.


