WHEREAS, the Columbia Police Department has agreed to solicit charitable contributions on behalf of the Special Olympics South Carolina; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, South Carolina this 4<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2012 that Columbia Police Department personnel are permitted to solicit charitable contributions on behalf of Special Olympics South Carolina on Wednesday, September 26, 2012, September 27, 2012 and Friday, September 28, 2012 at the intersections Leesburg Road, Dorn Avenue and Garners Ferry Road, provided, however, that:

- (1) There is no interference with either vehicular or pedestrian traffic;
- (2) No personnel shall leave the curb or raised median while soliciting for or collecting funds; and
- (3) Personnel shall remove all trash from the sidewalk and median.


