Have you ever wanted to learn about throwing pottery, but want a class that meets during the day? If so, this is the class for you. This course will provide students with the knowledge necessary to learn the basics and continue throwing pottery. At the end of the course, students may elect to continue with Open Studio, or advance to the next level of throwing – “Next Step Throwing: Building on the Basics”.

Some of the skills that will be taught:

- Learning to center clay on the wheel
- Learning to throw shapes
- Learning about trimming and glazing

Requirements:

- Registration fee covers instruction and operational costs.
- Students must have their own pottery tools (Tool kits are available at the Art Center for \$10).
- Minimum number of students: 3
- Maximum number of students: 8
