

SS7510 Metro WWTP Emergency Generators

Project Description: The purpose of this project is to provide the Headworks and Administration Building at the Metro WWTP with emergency power in the event of a power failure. The Metro WWTP currently has no generators in place to continue wastewater treatment during a storm event that causes a lapse in electrical power. This construction contract will allow us to install the two natural gas generators and associated appurtenances.

Objectives: This project will provide some electrical infrastructure for the operation of the WW Treatment Plant functions during emergency storm events.

Project Type: Improvements and Efficient Operations; Regulatory Compliance.

Council District: System-wide

Project Funding: This project is being funded through a FEMA HMGP federal grant program at the amount of \$8,935,760.00.

Current Project Status: Now that construction bids have been received, pending approval, the construction could start March 2025.
